## BASIC INFORMATION

---

Sunset Pilates Bali's 4-Week Immersive Mat and Reformer Pilates Teacher Training is an established professional education program led by Master Instructor Saria Bartholomew. Saria has led 20+ Pilates teacher training programs across the United States and Bali, preparing instructors with the knowledge, practical experience, and teaching skills required to teach Pilates safely, confidently, and professionally.

This 518-hour program combines intensive in-class education with structured observation, self-practice, and practice teaching. Students develop a strong understanding of functional anatomy, biomechanics, movement analysis, Pilates repertoire, programming, cueing, and professional teaching practices while receiving individualized feedback throughout the course.

The curriculum integrates contemporary movement science with the principles and repertoire of Classical Pilates, emphasizing critical thinking, movement quality, and the ability to adapt exercises to meet the needs of individual clients.

**Class sizes are limited to 10 participants** to provide individualized instruction, personalized feedback, and close mentorship throughout the program. The course is taught in **English** at Sunset Pilates Bali and may also be delivered at other approved training locations.

## EDUCATIONAL PHILOSOPHY

This program is founded on the belief that effective Pilates instruction extends beyond memorizing exercises and choreography. Competent instructors understand *why* movement is performed, *how* the body responds to movement, and *when* exercises should be modified to meet the needs of each individual client.

Throughout the program, emphasis is placed on movement quality over choreography, critical thinking over memorization, and developing strong observation skills. Students learn to recognize movement patterns, identify common compensations, and make informed teaching decisions based on the individual in front of them rather than relying on a one-size-fits-all approach.

The goal of this program is not simply to teach Pilates exercises, but to develop knowledgeable, adaptable, and confident instructors who can deliver safe, effective, and client-centered instruction across a variety of settings.

Instruction combines contemporary, evidence-informed teaching principles with significant exposure to the Classical Pilates repertoire, providing students with a broad understanding of the Pilates method while developing the practical skills required for professional instruction.

1. Students are required to maintain a detailed log of all practical hours, including dates, duration, activity type, and location. Logs may be reviewed and verified at the discretion of the program instructor
2. As part of the Mat self practice requirements, students are required to submit a video of themselves executing and verbally cueing the [Classical Mat](#) series in order from start to finish, with organized transitions. Appropriate modifications and deconstructions are encouraged

## FULFILLING PRACTICAL HOURS

---

Students must complete all required practical hours before becoming eligible to sit for the final examination. Practical hours may be completed at approved training locations or in the student's local area:

### 1. Practice Teaching

- Practice teaching hours can be completed at Sunset Pilates Bali, at other Pilates studios (with permission, rental fees may apply), or on home equipment
- Equipment rental fees will apply at Sunset Pilates for private clients (150K IDR per client, per hour)

### 2. Observation

- Students can observe live classes and private sessions in-studio at Sunset Pilates Bali or at other Pilates studios with permission. At least half of observation hours should be live, in-person
- Observation hours can also be completed by watching pre-recorded classes via Pilates Anytime and other approved online resources

### 3. Self Practice

- Self practice hours can be completed at Sunset Pilates Bali, at other Pilates studios (with permission, fees may apply), or on home equipment

- Equipment rental fees (125K IDR per hour) will apply at Sunset Pilates starting one month after in-class training. The first month after training is free

Students will be informed of the studio's schedule by studio staff and will be expected to maintain studio etiquette while they are in the space.

## FINAL EXAM

---

Students become eligible to sit for the final examination after successfully completing all required practical hours. Test out date/time will be decided by the student and Master Instructor Saria. The final exam can be completed in-person or via Zoom.

The final examination assesses competency in applied anatomy, repertoire knowledge, program design, cueing, safety, and professional conduct.

Students are expected to demonstrate competency across all material presented throughout the program. Applied theoretical knowledge is assessed verbally through scenario-based questioning during the examination.

Students must demonstrate safe and professional performance in both exam components.

If competency is not demonstrated, students may retake the examination after additional preparation. Students will be required to pay the final exam fee again.

Assessment decisions are based on professional competency standards established by the NPCP.

### **The exam has two main parts:**

- 1. Teaching Proficiency Exam:** Teach a 50 min session to a client or small group. Students must demonstrate the ability to apply program structure and repertoire.

This portion of the exam can be taken online via Zoom, in-person, or it can be pre-recorded and sent to the Master Instructor for assessment.

Evaluation criteria include:

- Clear and accurate exercise instruction
- Appropriate use of verbal and demonstration cueing
- Safe exercise selection and progression
- Ability to modify exercises based on client needs
- Professional communication and teaching presence

- Logical class structure and flow
- 2. Movement Proficiency Exam:** Demonstrate selected exercises from the Pilates repertoire. Exercises will be randomly chosen.

Appropriate modifications are encouraged. Students will be expected to verbally cue as they perform the movement. If asked, they will also be required to explain how to approach teaching the exercise in specific scenarios.

Evaluation criteria include:

- Correct execution of exercise technique
- Appropriate body control and coordination
- Ability to demonstrate modifications when needed
- Accurate verbal cueing while performing movements

### **Is this a Classical or Contemporary Pilates program?**

This is a Contemporary Pilates teacher training program with significant exposure to the Classical Pilates repertoire. Students learn the traditional exercises while also developing the movement analysis, critical thinking, and teaching skills needed to safely adapt exercises for individual clients.

### **What language is the course taught in?**

Fluency is not required, but students should feel comfortable learning in English.

### **How many students are accepted into each course?**

Class sizes are limited to 10 participants to provide individualized instruction, personalized feedback, and close mentorship throughout the immersive training. Small class sizes also allow

students more opportunities for supervised teaching practice and direct interaction with the Master Instructor.

### **Do I need prior Pilates experience?**

No. Prior Pilates teaching experience or a regular Pilates practice is not required. The most important prerequisite is a genuine interest in learning, a willingness to participate, and a commitment to the educational process.

## **Certification**

### **Will I be qualified to teach after completing the course?**

Graduates who successfully complete the four-week immersive training will have completed the in-class educational component of the program and may begin working toward their required practical hours. During this period, students may be eligible to work as apprentice or student instructors, depending on the policies of the studio or employer.

Upon completion of the immersive training, students receive an official letter confirming they have successfully completed the educational component of the program and are actively completing their remaining practical hour requirements.

Once all practical hours and the final examination have been successfully completed, graduates are awarded their 518-hour Mat and Reformer Pilates Teacher Training Certificate.

### **What is the National Pilates Certification Program (NPCP)?**

The National Pilates Certification Program (NPCP) is the Pilates industry's leading independent third-party certification organization in the United States.

Accredited by the National Commission for Certifying Agencies (NCCA), the NPCP establishes nationally recognized competency standards for Pilates instructors through a comprehensive certification examination. It is widely regarded as the gold standard for independent professional certification in the Pilates industry.

### **What is the difference between a training certificate and NPCP certification?**

A teacher training certificate documents successful completion of a professional education program and demonstrates that a graduate has met the program's educational and practical requirements.

NPCP certification is a separate professional credential earned by passing an independent competency examination. It provides third-party validation of an instructor's knowledge and competency.

### **Is NPCP certification required to teach?**

No. Pilates instruction is not regulated internationally, and most instructors begin teaching after successfully completing a professional teacher training program. Third-party certification through the NPCP is optional and represents an additional professional credential.

### **Is PMA membership the same as certification?**

No. Membership in the Pilates Method Alliance (PMA) is a professional association membership and does not provide instructor certification.

### **Can I teach internationally with this certificate? Is it internationally recognized?**

Yes. Sunset Pilates Bali's Teacher Training Program is designed to prepare instructors for professional teaching opportunities worldwide. Graduates of this program are teaching Pilates in more than 35 countries, demonstrating the program's broad international relevance and applicability.

The curriculum reflects internationally recognized professional competencies and has been designed in alignment with the competency domains recognized by the NPCP.

Graduates are encouraged to familiarize themselves with any special local requirements that may apply where they intend to teach.

## **Practical Hours**

### **How long do I have to complete my practical hours?**

There is no formal deadline for completing the required practical hours. Students are encouraged to complete them at a pace that allows for meaningful learning, regular practice, and the development of strong teaching skills before taking the final examination.

### **Can I complete my practical hours outside of Bali?**

Yes. Practical hours may be completed at approved Pilates studios, on home equipment where appropriate, or at other approved training locations. Students are responsible for maintaining accurate logbooks and fulfilling all program requirements.

## **Final Examination**

### **What happens if I do not pass the final examination?**

Students who do not demonstrate the required level of competency may retake the examination after additional preparation. A new final examination fee will apply.
